The Convocation is a solemn and proud occasion where the university confers Degrees and Diplomas upon its graduating students, who pledge to dedicate themselves to their professions and to the cause of human development. It is also a moment to reflect on our achievements, review the progress of the past years, and outline the roadmap for the years ahead. In today's convocation, a total of 657 students will be awarded Degrees and Diplomas, and 18 Gold Medals will be presented to the programme toppers.

Kaushalya – The Skill University, established by the Government of Gujarat under the Kaushalya – The Skill University Act, 2021, is India's first-of-its-kind affiliating state skill university, dedicated to promoting skill-based higher education.

The university commenced its first academic session in July 2022, offering a wide range of innovative and industry-aligned programmes through its six schools, and has demonstrated remarkable growth over the past three years. At present, Kaushalya – The Skill University (KSU) has 31 affiliated partners and 38 academic and strategic collaborators, with 657 students having successfully completed degree and diploma programmes, and 12,001 candidates trained through short-term certificate courses during this period.

The university currently operates from its temporary campuses at VGEC Campus, Chandkheda, Ahmedabad, and Mahatma Gandhi Labour Institute (MGLI), Memnagar, Ahmedabad, and will soon shift to its permanent campus at Shilaj, Ahmedabad by March 2026, which is under construction with a built-up area of 55,000 square metres. The foundation of KSU lies in the visionary guidance of our Hon'ble Prime Minister, who envisaged the establishment of sectoral universities to strengthen our nation. This vision was brought to life under the dynamic leadership of the Hon'ble Minister for Labour, Skill Development and Employment, Shri Balvantsinh Rajput Sir.

We gratefully acknowledge the contributions of Former Chief Secretaries of Government of Gujarat Shri Pankaj Kumar, IAS, and Shri Raj Kumar, IAS. We also acknowledge the contributions and leadership of Dr. Anju Sharma, IAS, the founding Director General of the university, for their pivotal roles in shaping KSU's journey.

Our students come from humble backgrounds but demonstrate exceptional discipline, sincerity, and determination to build careers that contribute to the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of making India the "Skill Capital of the World."

We offer a diverse range of academic and vocational programmes such as:

Stone Craft and Design, Computer Science (AI, ML, IoT, Cyber Security), Management, Psychology, Labour Laws, Steel Technology, Drone Technology, Medical Laboratory Technology, Biotechnology, Green and Renewable Energy, Furniture Design, Logistics, EV Assembly, Fashion Design, Industrial Safety, Solar PV Manufacturing, Wind Farm Technology, and many others. Each programme is designed with an integrated component of internship, on-the-job training, or apprenticeship, ensuring every graduate attains hands-on industry experience and is fully employable upon completion.

I am proud to share that our students maintain an average attendance of above 85%, reflecting their commitment to learning and their enthusiasm for skill-based education.

Dear Graduands, as you step into the world beyond these walls, remember that education gives you knowledge, but skill gives you power. The true measure of your learning lies in your ability to adapt, innovate, and lead with integrity. Be proud ambassadors of Kaushalya – The Skill University, upholding its values of diligence, creativity, and service to society.

About the Convocation

The ceremony provides an opportunity to award diplomas and undergraduate degrees to the students. It signifies the culmination of their academic, emotional, and cultural journey, complemented by on-the-job training, apprenticeships, and internships. The dedication and hard work of these students highlight their commitment to skill-based careers. A total of 657 students will be awarded their degrees and diplomas during the ceremony.

1. The University

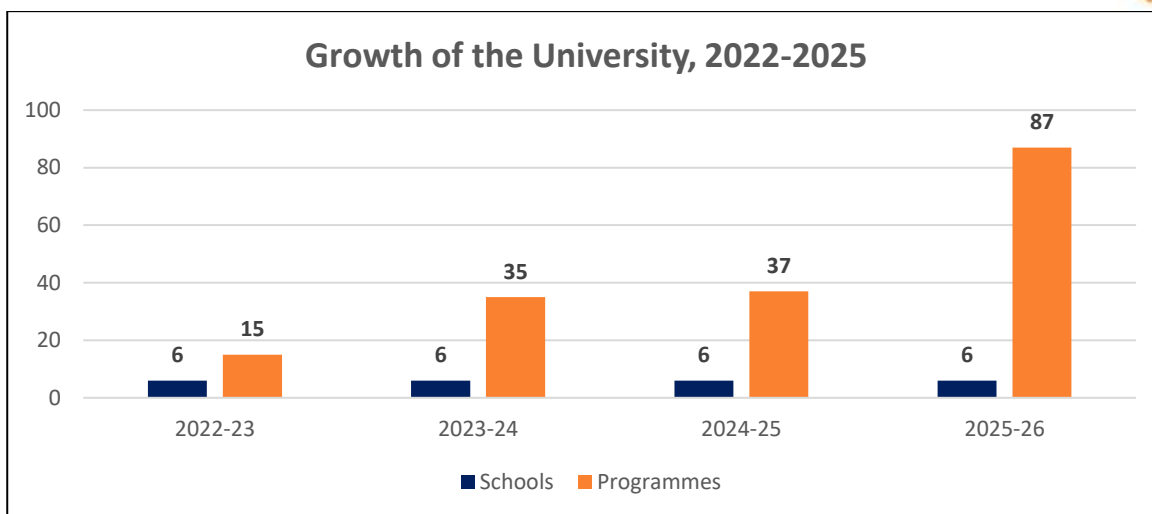
KSU is established by the Labour, Skill Development and Employment Department, Government of Gujarat). The university offers a range of programs across six schools: School of Liberal Arts, School of Computing, School of Science Manufacturing and Infrastructure, School of Drones, and School of Healthcare, Agriculture, and Other Services. Since its inception, the university has experienced significant growth. It currently has 10 faculty members, 13 Assistant Skill Coordinator, 12 staff members, and 42 outsourced personnel. Over the past Three years, 12,658 students have completed their undergraduate degrees, diploma and short-term certificate programs.

1.1. Growth of the University

It is encouraging to observe the steady growth in the number of programmes since the inception of Kaushalya – The Skill University. The University commenced its journey in 2022 with six schools, offering a total of 15 programmes. By 2023, the number of programmes had increased to 35, marking a significant expansion in academic offerings.

There has been no looking back since then — in 2024, the University offered 37 programmes, and as of the current academic year, 87 programmes are being delivered across its six schools of study. In addition, the University has also introduced Ph.D. programmes in various disciplines across schools.

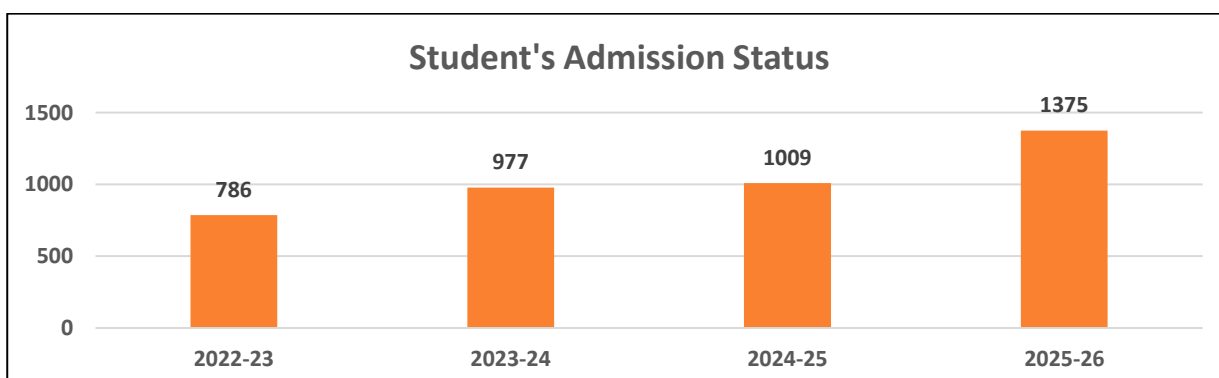

1.2. Student Strength

Kaushalya - The Skill University has emerged as one of the most preferred destinations for higher education in skill-based courses, attracting students from both the local region and other states across the country. For our diploma and degree programmes, which have a minimum duration of one year, the number of students has increased from 786 in 2022 to 977 in 2023, 1,009 in 2024, and 1,375 in 2025. In the short-term certificate courses, the university has conducted 22 certificate programs and trained 12,001 students over the past three years.

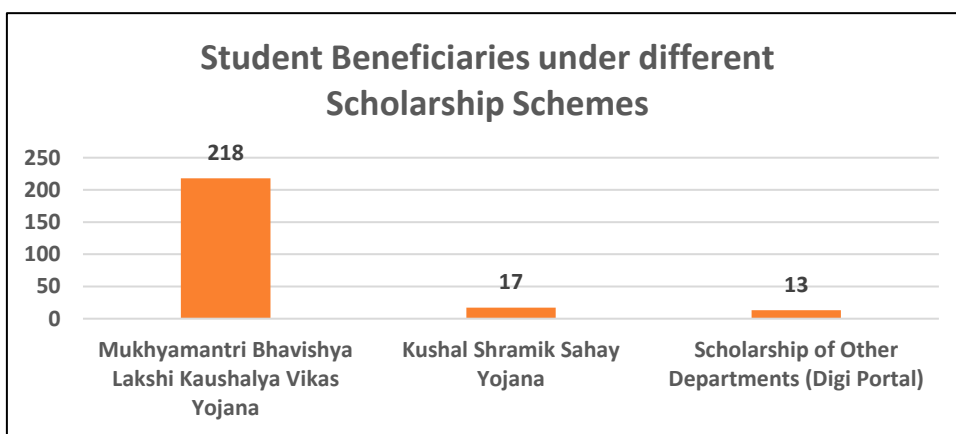

1.3. Student Scholarships

The students of Kaushalya – The Skill University (KSU) have been awarded scholarships under various categories to promote inclusive and equitable access to education. During the Academic Year 2023–24, a total of 275 students benefited from scholarship schemes amounting to ₹45,96,000. In 2024–25, 248 students received scholarships totalling ₹44,59,050.

The scholarships were disbursed under different Government schemes, as illustrated in the graph below.



1.4. Infrastructural Facilities

The university began the construction of its new campus at Shilaj in November 2022, with an expected completion date of March 2026. Total 13 acers of land have been allotted by the State Government at the Block no. 1315, 1316, 1317 and 1319 at Shilaj, Ta. Ghatlodia, Dist. Ahmedabad.

The total built up area of the facilities is going to be more than 55,000 sq. mt. Currently, the university is operating from the temporary campus of Chandkheda: Block-3, VGEC Campus, Chandkheda, Ahmedabad-382424 and at Mahatma Gandhi Labour Institute (MGLI), Drive-in-Road, Memnagar, Ahmedabad-380052.

The Project is halfway through, with

- Central Block – RCC work completed
- North Block – up to 9th floor RCC work partially completed
- South Block – up to 8th floor RCC work partially completed
- Hostel Block – up to 4th floor completed

2. Academic Activities

The University offers a wide range of skill development programs and short-term certificate courses. Students can choose from various options, including courses like Ph.D, Masters, UG Degree, UG Diploma, UG Certificates, Post Graduate Diploma, Post Diploma, Advance Diploma, Short-term certificate and more.

All programs at the University include a mandatory skilling component, either through day-to-day training via On-the-Job Training (OJT) or through regular internships, with a compulsory apprenticeship or internship in the final year of the three-year undergraduate programs. The university follows the guidelines set by the National Education Policy (NEP), National Credit Framework (NCRF), and the National Skill Qualifications Framework (NSQF). In 2024, the university introduced a compulsory Behavioural Science course for students in BCA, MSc, and BBA programs at the KSU campus. This course is expected to expand in the future with affiliated partners. The university also offers a unique Drone Pilot program, from its 06 centres accredited as an RPTO (Remote Pilot Training Organization) by DGCA, along with a drone manufacturing course at Raipur campus, Ahmedabad.

Students at the university are highly engaged in their courses, with an average class attendance of over 80%. Faculty members consistently conduct all scheduled classes, ensuring minimal disruption in the learning process.

2.1. Process Automation

KSU successfully transitioned to the Samarth Portal of Government of India in 2025, marking a significant step toward digitization and process integration. Prior to this transition, the University was operating on an ERP system provided by an external vendor. Beginning with the Academic Session 2025–26, all academic and administrative data — including student results, examination records, and attendance — are being processed exclusively through the Samarth platform.

Out of the 43 modules available under Samarth, the University in last 5-6 months has successfully implemented 11 modules, with plans to gradually operationalize the remaining modules in a phased manner.

Furthermore, the University is registered with the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) portal, enabling seamless mapping and transfer of students' earned credits to other recognized universities, in accordance with UGC guidelines.

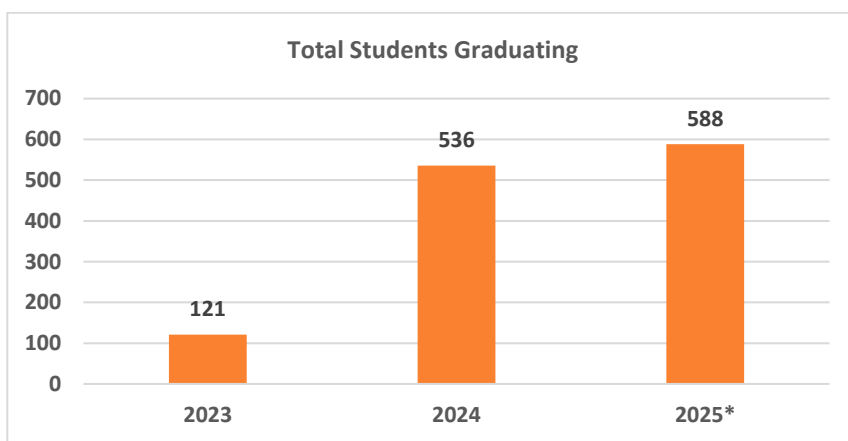
Additionally, the University is integrated with DigiLocker, allowing students to securely access their marksheets, diplomas, and degree certificates through their personal DigiLocker accounts, ensuring authenticity and ease of digital verification. Today all the diploma and degree awarded in the convocation will be uploaded on DigiLocker during the convocation ceremony

2.2. Number of Graduating Students

A total of 121 students graduated in 2023, comprising 22 Diploma, 60 Post Diploma, and 39 Post Graduate Diploma recipients. In 2024, the University recorded a significant increase, with 536 students

graduating — including 21 Advanced Diploma, 266 Post Diploma, 106 Post Graduate Diploma, and 143 Undergraduate students.

This brings the cumulative number of graduates to 657, who will be conferred their respective diplomas and degrees during the First Convocation Ceremony. In the year 2025, 588 students are expected to be graduated.

2.3. MoU and Affiliated Partners

Since its inception, the university has signed a total of 91 Memoranda of Understanding (MoU) has been done. In 2022-23, 37 MoUs were signed, in 2023-24, 31 MoUs were signed and in academic year 2024-25, 08 MoUs. For the academic year 2025-26, 15 MOUs have been signed so far.

The MOUs signed by the University are categorized into several key areas. A total number of active MOUs are 69 out of 91 till the date. Out of which 31 MOUs has been signed with industries as affiliated partners, facilitating industry collaboration. Additionally, 9 MOUs have been signed with academic institutions to enable credit transfer. The university has also signed 11 MOUs with international partners and associations, aimed at leveraging their expertise for curriculum development, training, and providing internships for our students. Furthermore, 18 MOUs have been signed with strategic partners for broader, long-term collaborations, covering areas such as academic research, consultancy, and project work. The most recent MOUs signed by KSU in 2025 further strengthen these collaborations.

3. Research Activities, Awards and Recognitions

The faculty members and students of KSU have been actively engaged in high-impact research activities since its inception. To date, the university has achieved a total of ten high-impact research publications, six book chapters, and two books. The university has also received a project grant, including a CSR fund of ₹ 11.51 lakh for the establishment of the Life Science lab.

Faculty members across all schools of Kaushalya – The Skill University actively contributed to academic and professional growth through research, FDPs, certifications, and student engagement activities. During the year, notable achievements included publications, invited talks, FDP participation/conduction, professional certifications, and organization of events, workshops, and industrial visits.

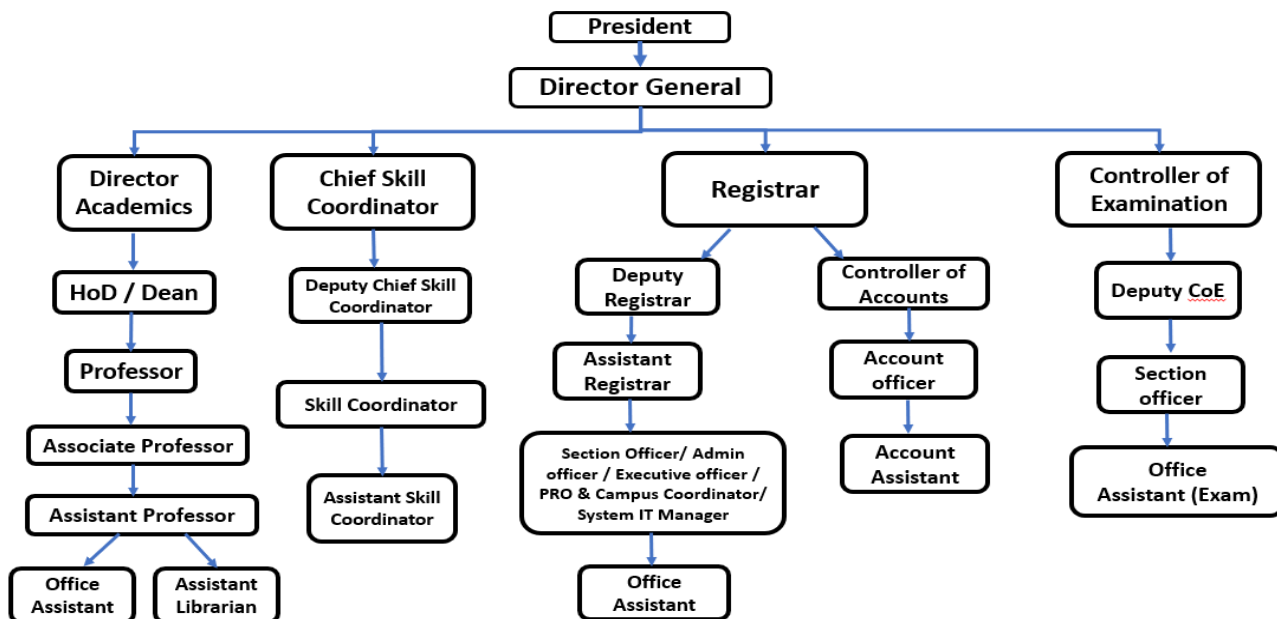

The students of KSU have reached several milestones across various events. Notably, three students from the BSc Furniture Manufacturing and Design program have achieved recognition in India Skill Competition by receiving silver and bronze medals.

4. Human Resource

University has a total faculty strength of 10 Out of which 100% are Ph.D. holders and they are drawn from best of the University/Institution from India and abroad which includes University of Sheffield (UK), IIT Kanpur, Central Universities and various renowned State Universities.



The University has 77 number of staff members including Registrar, Deputy Registrar and other offices. A unique feature of KSU as Skill University is reflected by setting up of positions of Chief Skill Coordinators, Deputy Chief Skill Coordinators, Skill Coordinators, along with one Assistant Skill coordinators in each School. This combination helps KSU to blend the skill with academics in a best possible manner. All courses are developed jointly by academic and skill team of KSU and passed by different bodies like Board of Studies, Academic Council, and Skill development Council as applicable.

5. Special Achievements

Twenty-seven BBA students from Kaushalya – The Skill University (KSU) successfully cleared the National Financial Literacy Quiz, demonstrating the institution’s focus on holistic skill development and financial awareness.

Achievements in the Aera of drone technology & trainees:

KSU also achieved a significant milestone by becoming the first institution in Gujarat to receive DGCA-approved "Train the Trainer (TTT)" certification for Rotorcraft and Small Category Drones under its School of Drones. This certification empowers the University to train and certify drone trainers across the country, strengthening the national drone training ecosystem.

Scaling Up the Network of RPTOs across Gujarat

KSU currently operates DGCA-approved Remote Pilot Training Organisations (RPTOs) at its Swarnim and Shilaj campuses, having successfully completed 621 drone pilot training programs. The University aims to train over 20,000 youth within the next three years by expanding its network to 19 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The initiative also includes the introduction of Drone Manufacturing & Assembly programs, along with the provision of drone simulators and DIY kits to enhance hands-on learning.

Four new RPTOs have been approved at ITI Mandvi, Bilimora, Kalawad, and Amreli, while DGCA inspections are pending for ITI Patan, Palanpur, and Himatnagar, further strengthening the state-wide drone training infrastructure.

Production of 100 Type-Certified “Kaushalya Drones”

The prototype of the “Kaushalya Drone” was unveiled on 25th March 2023, and the University received its DGCA Type Certification on 15th February 2024. Manufactured at the Drone MANTRA facility, these drones will support the establishment of 19 new drone training centres across Gujarat. A total of 100 Type-Certified Kaushalya Drones have already been produced and distributed to selected ITIs, ensuring affordable and localized access to drone training for youth across the state.

6. Academic Reforms

This university rigorously adheres to the guidelines and norms set by all statutory bodies, including the University Grants Commission (UGC). The average student attendance across all courses offered at KSU, including those with affiliated partners, consistently exceeds 80%. The university maintains strict attendance protocols, ensuring that students who fall below the required attendance threshold, as per UGC regulations, are debarred from sitting for their final exams. This policy has significantly contributed to improved classroom attendance.

In line with national educational policies, KSU has implemented the National Education Policy (NEP), the National Credit Framework (NCRF), and the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF). The university conducts various programs in accordance with these frameworks, aligning its courses with the NCRF. Under this framework, credits are calculated based on a standard of thirty notional hours of learning, and syllabi and timetables are structured accordingly.

KSU has fully embraced the Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit (MEME) system, a significant reform in higher education. The university offers a 3-year undergraduate program with the option for students to exit with a certificate after one year, a diploma after two years, or a full undergraduate degree after three years. Students who initially enrol in the certificate course can choose to continue their education by upgrading to a diploma, and later to a degree. Students enrolled in the degree program have the flexibility to exit after one or two years with a certificate or diploma as .

7. Library

The KSU Library continued to serve as a vital academic and research support hub, strengthening its alignment with NEP 2020 and the University’s mission of skill-based education. The library expanded its print and digital resources, introduced educational movie sessions, and enhanced its digital infrastructure through integration with NDLI, Shodhganga, and the One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) initiative. It supported teaching, research, and student engagement through orientation programmes, digital access services, and awareness initiatives. With increasing usage, memberships, and circulation, the library remains central to fostering a culture of continuous learning and academic excellence at KSU. Looking ahead, it plans to scale its digital infrastructure, introduce advanced management systems, and develop an Institutional Repository as part of the transition to the new campus.

8. Events and Expo

The University actively organizes and participates in a wide range of academic events, seminars, workshops, and industry expos throughout the year. These initiatives aim to enhance students' practical learning, industry exposure, and professional networking. Each event is carefully curated to align with emerging trends and skill requirements, fostering collaboration between academia and industry while providing students with valuable experiential learning opportunities.

8.1. World Youth Skill Day - 2024: Pyskill Quest

The Python Skill Competition, held on 15th July 2024 during World Youth Skill Day, showcased global talent in Python programming. Organized by WorldSkills International, the event highlighted Python's importance in software development and problem-solving.



8.2. Diksharambh - Induction Program - 2024

Kaushalya – The Skill University held a six-day induction programme (29th July–3rd August 2024) for 94 new BBA and BCA students. The event included expert lectures, sessions on management, technology, sustainability, and entrepreneurship, along with interactive activities and cultural events. Three new units—Sustainability Club, Cyber Club, and NSS—were inaugurated. 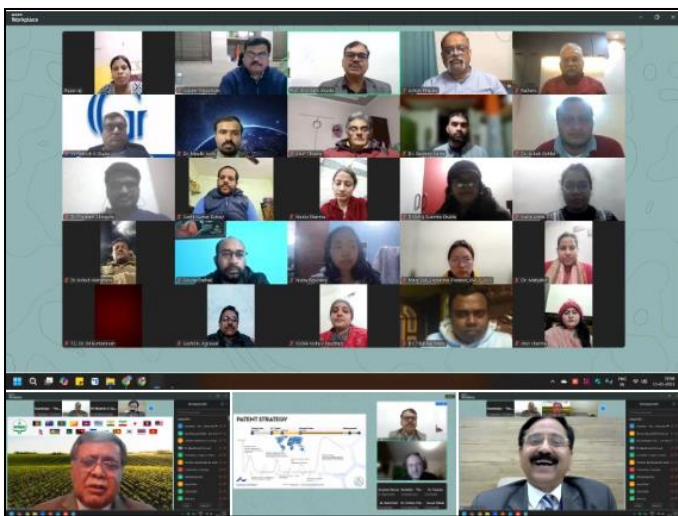
8.9. Celebration of World Teachers’ Day

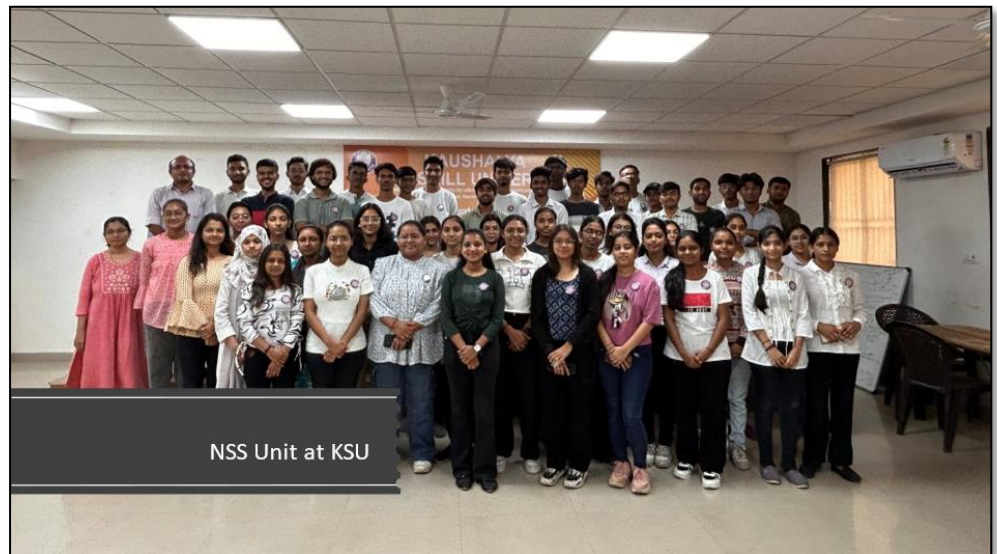


8.20. Tree Plantation

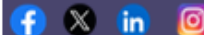
